## **Rules and Guidelines**

- Stable hours are 6:00am - 10:00pm unless otherwise arranged. (exceptions can certainly be made for shows, etc.)
- No Smoking
- Absolutely no dogs
- You are responsible for yourselves, guests and children. Please don't leave children or guests unattended
- Everyone must sign a liability waiver before riding... no exceptions (copies will be made available)
- Always use the proper safety equipment. The Farm is not responsible for any injury, accident and/or death due to failure to take proper safety precautions.
- Please return all tools, such as forks, brooms, wheelbarrows, etc. to their proper place when finished
- Please clean up after your horse in all the common areas
- Due to limited storage, please keep rarely used tack and equipment at home
- Please hose/wash in designated area only
- Please inform BuckMann Farm of any vet/farrier/instructor visits as early as possible
- You are expected to be present for any vet/farrier visits. If you cannot be available, you can employ management services for an additional fee
- Please respect each other's belongings
- Do not give any horse treats, other than your own without permission of other owners. Some equines may have stomach problems associated with some treats.
- Please check lights, gates and doors that you may have turned on or opened before leaving
- Do not feed your horse unless discussed with management. If you feel that your horses feeding needs to be modified, please let the Farm know, as modifications may cause colic or stomach problems.
- No bicycles or motorized vehicles in or around the barn

## **Rate Schedule**

Pasture Board: \$175.00 per month per horse  
Stall with daily turnout: \$275.00 per month per horse  
Late Fees: \$25.00 after the 5<sup>th</sup>, \$50.00 after the 10<sup>th</sup>  
Farrier/Vet holding and assistance: \$20.00 per visit  
Wound care: \$20.00 per day  
Security Deposit: \$50.00 per horse pasture/\$100.00 per horse stall board
